What is Hear2Help?

Our monthly Hear2Help sessions are a local lifeline for people who need support to keep their hearing aids in good working order.

We run several monthly sessions for adults in community venues across Nottingham & Nottinghamshire.

What are you looking for?

We are looking for friendly, reliable people to run up to 10 Hear2Help sessions each month across Nottinghamshire. We are keen to grow Hear2Help and introduce new services and would love you to be part of that development. The role is part-time and we support flexible working. We will consider options such as job-sharing and location preference.

What is the role?

You will:

- Run monthly sessions at our venues. Each session lasts about 2 hours.
- Check hearing aids, carry out maintenance tasks and refer on to Audiology if needed.
- Liaise with the venue, manage stock, order spares and keep simple records.
- Be part of our friendly Hear Together team

We will:

- Provide all the equipment you need.
- Support you to get started & provide ongoing training.
- Pay for your time & travel.

Pay from £15/ hour dependent on experience. Successful applicants will require DBS clearance and references.
